Shepard's® Verify is a new citation-verification capability that identifies legal citations, checks them against LexisNexis® authoritative legal sources, flags citations that cannot be verified in our system, and displays *Shepard's* Signals™ where available.

Produce Defensible Work

Applies *Shepard's* verification to AI responses, documents created or uploaded content, catching what might otherwise be missed. *Shepard's* Signals are shown for cited sources.



Scale Quality

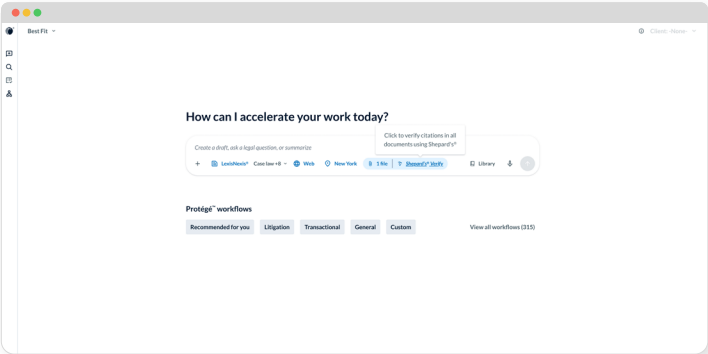
Surfaces citations that need further attention before work product reaches clients, colleagues or the court.

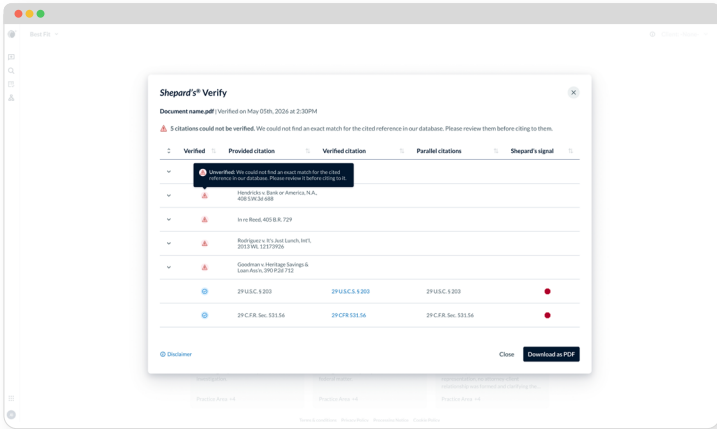
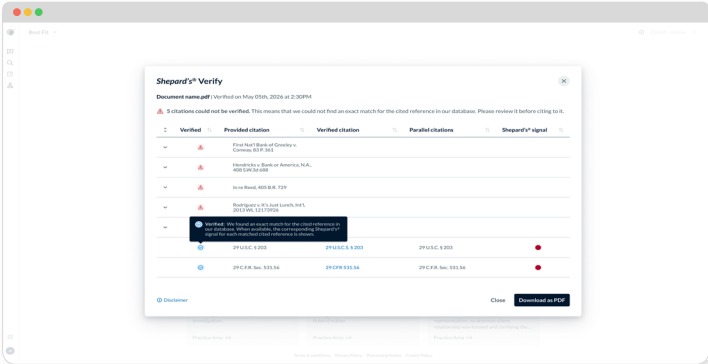
- ✓ Run *Shepard's* Verify on a single uploaded document or a single selected document from Vault directly from the prompt box.
- ✓ Check citations in Protégé™ responses, including answers to legal questions and drafted content that contain citations.
- ✓ View the analysis within the draft document, including citation-verification results.
- ✓ See links to verified authorities when a corresponding citation is found in LexisNexis authoritative legal sources.
- ✓ View *Shepard's* signals where available for verified citations.
- ✓ Download a citation-verification report for review, sharing, or attachment to downstream work product (available for drafts and uploaded documents only).

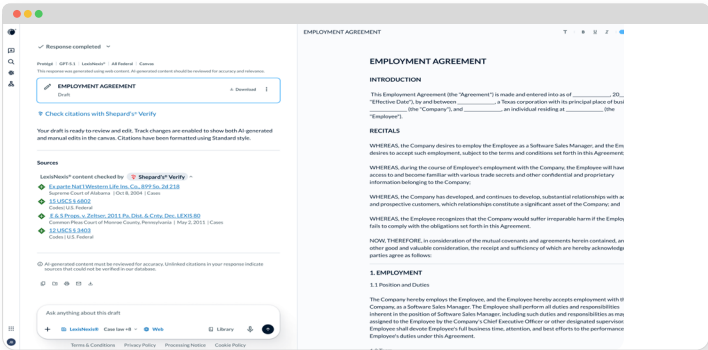
Invoke *Shepard's* Verify for a singly-uploaded document to instantly run a verification report.

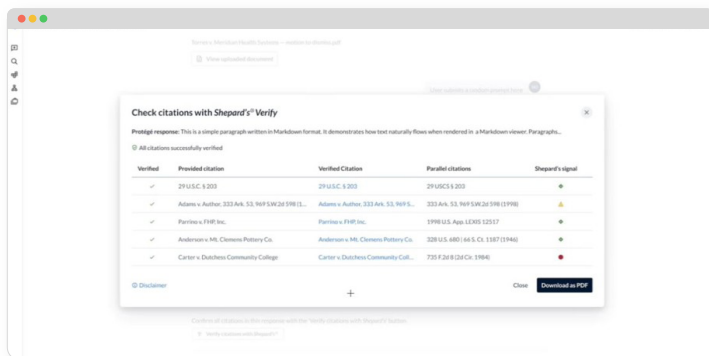
A verification summary report is available for single-uploaded documents for easy review of all citations within the document. Report contains a list of citations within the document with a link to the case and *Shepard's* Signal.



When *Shepard's* Verify cannot confirm an exact citation, the system provides suggestions for further user review. As appropriate, a suggestion may contain a closest match case for consideration within the report.

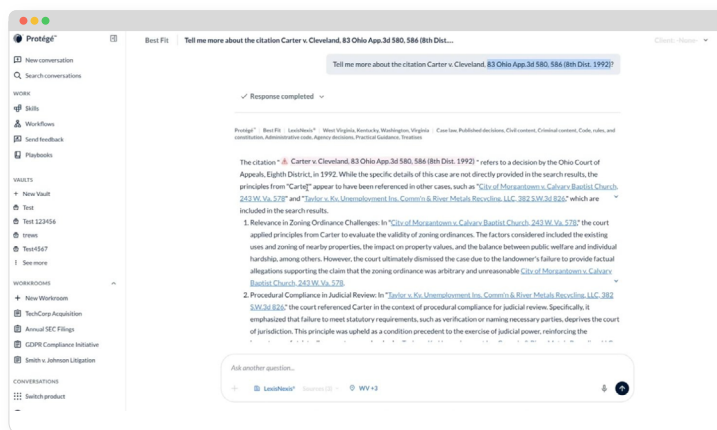
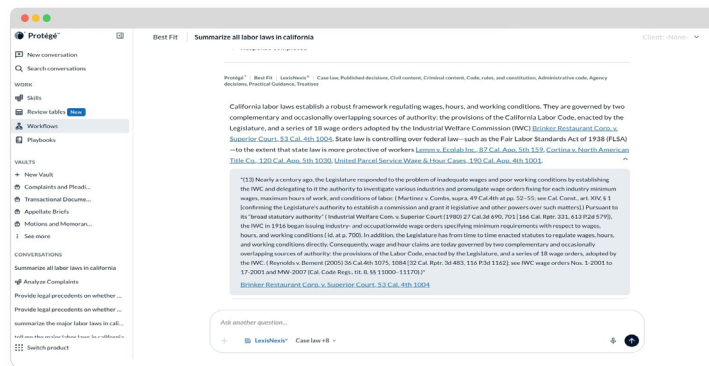
Users can invoke the *Shepard's* Verify function to produce a citation summary. Verify AI-generated drafts directly within the workflows.





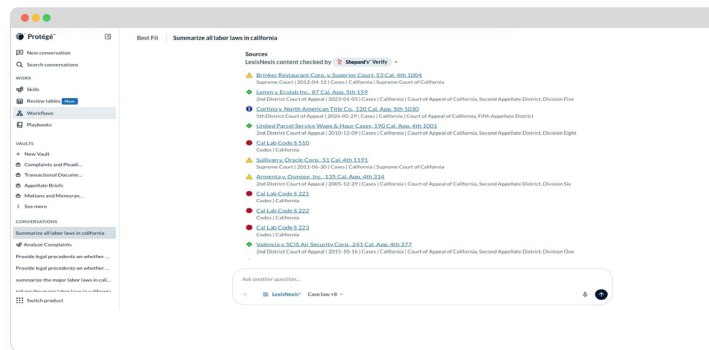
The same downloadable tabular report is available for drafted documents.

AI responses within the system is marked inline with *Shepard's* Verify result, while the case summary is available below the citation.



Unverified citations will be flagged with a pop-up warning, as well as shown inline.

A summary of citations can be found at the bottom of AI responses.
